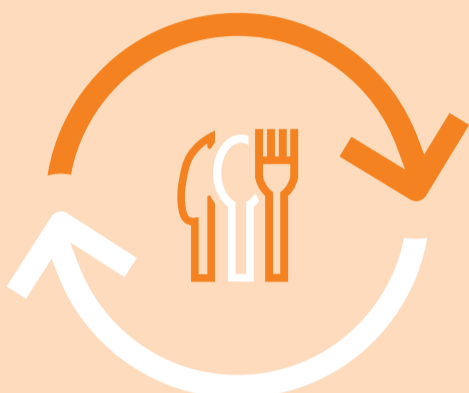

Food grade compliant according to EU directives 10/2011 and 1935/2004 so can be used in food production environments.

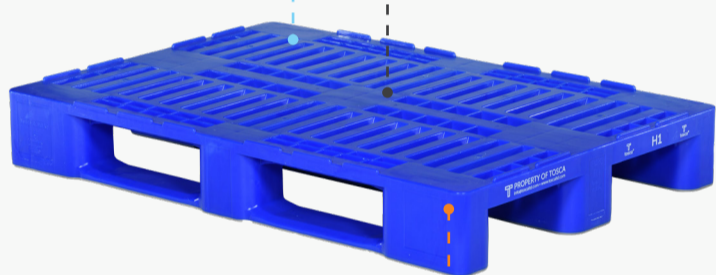
Made with virgin material without any harmful substances used during production. Pallets are also available in recycled material.

Transportation

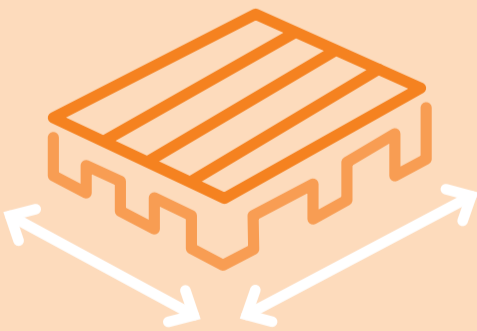
Plastic pallets are ISPM-15 exempt. No need to heat-treat plastic pallets for international shipments, streamlining your supply chain and keeping your products safe.
